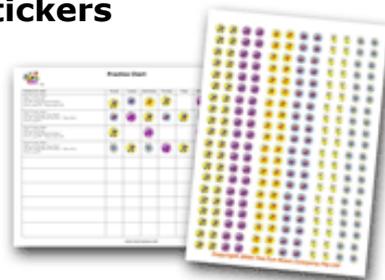


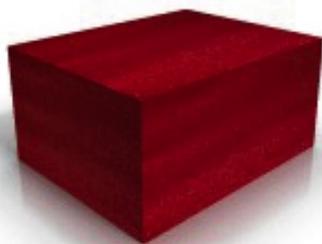
“Five Fun Ways to Inspire Children to Practice More”

Idea 1 - Practice Charts & Stickers

Practice Charts & Stickers don't need to be complicated to be effective - just a space to write down the tasks for a week, and a place to put a sticker each day.



Idea 2 - The “Special Box”



You can fill a box with lots of trinkets and fun things, they don't have to be expensive, but its the excitement of getting something from it that will inspire the practise!

Idea 3 - The “Hall of Fame”

Some children love the competitive element of this: You can get every child in your class, school or family involved, and have a reward for the child with the most stickers or points at the end of the term or year.



Idea 4 - Regular Rotation to keep it fresh



Make sure you always keep different ideas coming, and keep it fresh. Even the best practice charts or stickers will lose their effectiveness after time, so keep on introducing new ideas, new rewards and new games!

Idea 5 - “Make it a game”

Turning something into a **game** can take a boring theoretical concept and make it fun!

If a student actively involves themselves, and calls out the awnswers then they are far more likely to retain the information than if you simply tell them the information!
